Institutional Distinctiveness (2016-17)

The College maintains a Blood Group Data Registry which is updated every academic year. Voluntary blood donors are the cornerstone of a safe and adequate supply of whole blood as well as components of blood such as plasma. The safest blood donors are voluntary, nonremunerated blood donors from low-risk populations which include healthy individuals of relatively lower age group especially the college students. So as part of social commitment, the college regularly arranges blood donation campaigns. In the current academic year nearly 70 students and 8 faculty members have voluntarily participated in the blood donation. Apart from this as per the requirement, the students serve as blood donors for the nearby hospital blood banks.

The students at this college along with the teaching and non-teaching staff have taken steps to provide mid-day meal to the needy bystanders of patients at Government Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram. Towards realizing this commitment, students as well as the teaching and non-teaching staff have initiated a programme whereby packed food from their respective homes were brought to the campus on a bimonthly basis and was arranged for distribution.

The students of this college along with the NSS volunteers have taken initiative for public place cleaning, beautification and setting of organic vegetable garden at the nearby educational institutions.

Campus Cleaning and planting of tree sapling were carried out in the campus. The plants around the campus was taxonomically identified and displays were exhibited showing their taxonomic identification.
