Teaching and Learning: IQAC promoted the following:

ICT facility was used for conducting classes. Mentoring and career orientation was done through Walk with Scholar program/Scholar support program/ Remedial teaching. College follows tutorial system to provide a better understanding of individual students and bring out their highest potential. Department of Computer Science conducted Bridge course for the first year students. The attendance of the students was regularly monitored at the end of each semester by the College Level Monitoring Committee (CLMC).
