One faculty from Computer Science department and one from Statistics department have been awarded Ph.D. Two faculties one from Department of Biochemistry (worth 1.3 lakhs) and one from Geography (worth 2 lakhs) have Minor Research project. Faculties have made six presentations in International conferences, and four in National Seminars. Faculties have been Resource persons in total of seven conferences (one International, four national and two state levels). Faculties have published ten publications in International journals and two in National journals. Four faculty members have made contribution in book chapters. 84 faculty members have participated in various international, national and state level seminars and conferences.
