

REMEDIAL CLASS FOR SLOW LEARNERS

DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY 2021-22

The department of Geography mainly focus on remedial classes by two ways.

1. After University Exam remedial classes were given to those who need further improvement in results
2. After class test and internal exam, they were given remedial classes, peer group classes and retest were conducted and result were analysed

During the academic year 2021-22 the Department mainly focused on the remedial classes after S3 result of 2019 batch(Published on November 2021), S4 result of 2019 batch(Published on January 2022), S1 result of 2020 batch(published on March 2022) and S5(Published on April 2022) and S6 result of 2019 batch(Published on May 2022).

In case of S3 result out of 31 students 18 passed and 13 failed(13 in Statistics, 6 in Geology and two in Geography). Special remedial classes were given to two students failed in Geography. In S4 result out of 31 students, 20 passed and 11 failed(11 in Statistics, 5 in Geology and three in Geography). Remedial classes were taken and notes were given. In S1 BSc Geography results out of 38 students 29 passed and 9 failed.(6 in Statistics, Second Language and Geomorphology, Five in Geology and Foundation course and Two in English language skills. Six students failed in Geography classes were given remedial teaching and notes were provided.In case of S5 results, out of 31 students 28 passed and three failed and in terms of S6 result only one failed.The failed ones were provided study materials .

In terms of internal test, weak students were given remedial classes and re test were conducted and their result were analysed
