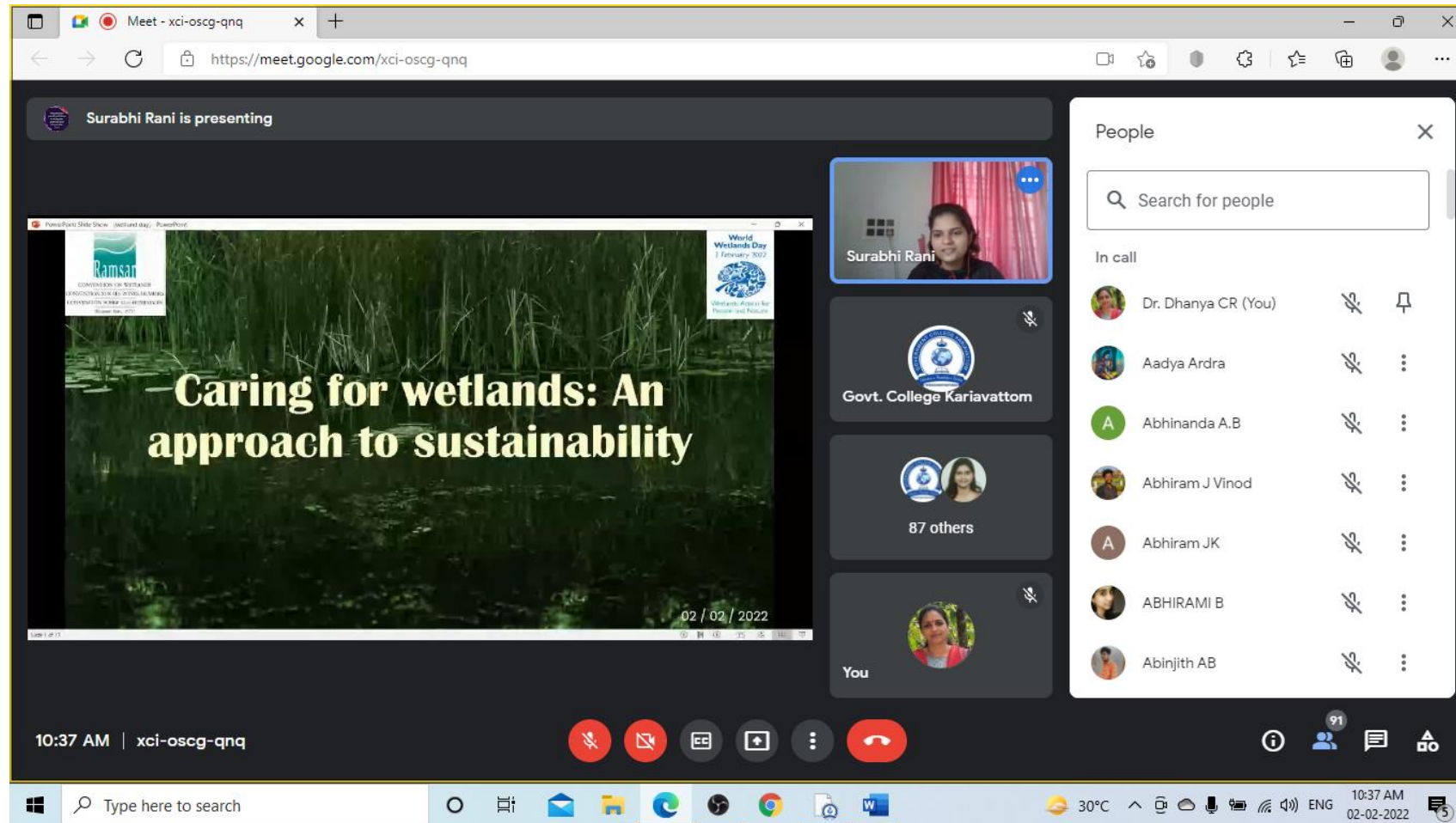

FOCAL THEMES OF WEBINAR

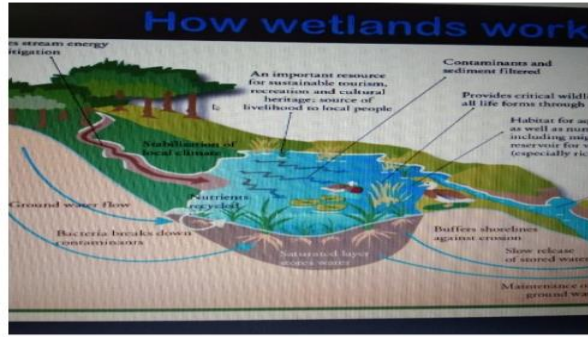

- The Ashtamudi lake system may become hyper saline if the reduced inflow of freshwater continues.
- Over the past one decade, there has been a reduction in inflow of freshwater to 40%, leading to increased salinity in the system.
- The extent of the wetland has also been reduced.
- Dumping of waste into the lake system is an issue of serious concern.
- The freshwater inflow has declined considerably since the Kallada dam became operational.






