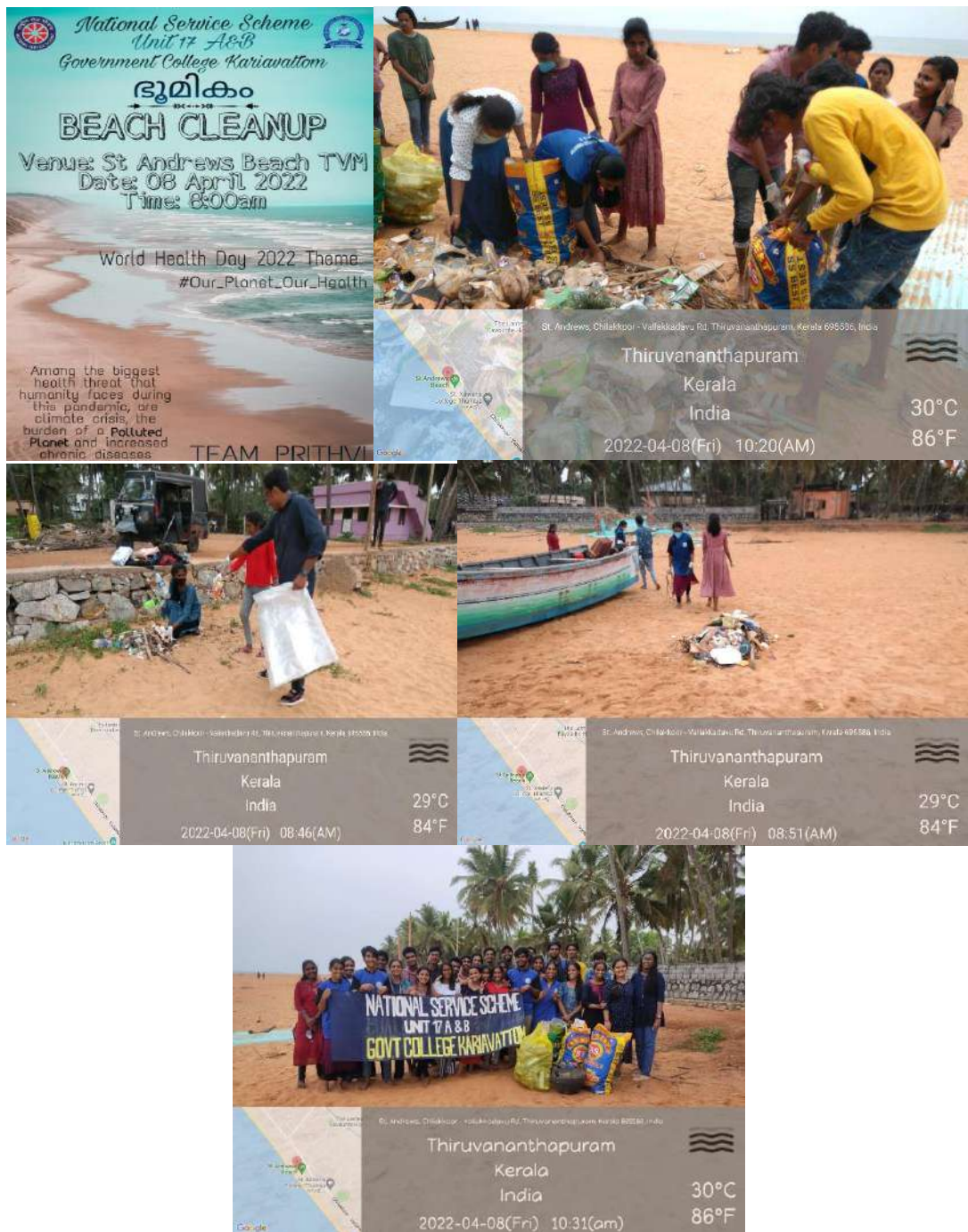
## Groups of 2021-23 enrolled Volunteers: Named after missiles of India

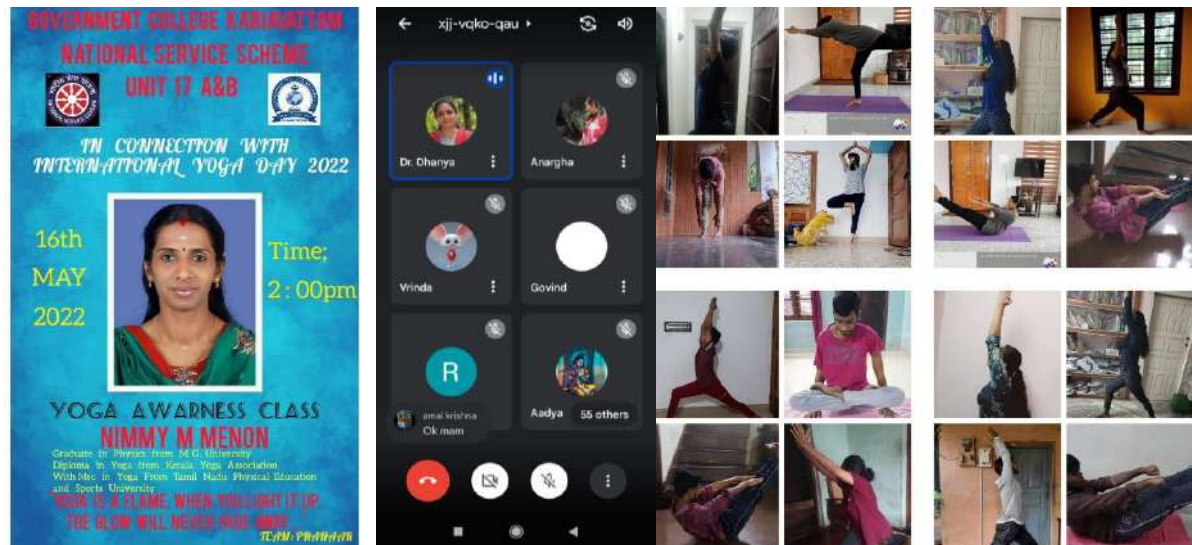






International Yoga day: Various programs were conducted on different days.

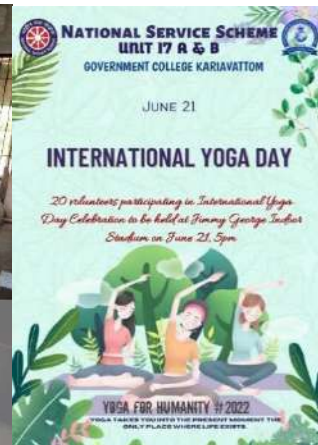
Online awareness class by Smt. Nimmy Menon, on **16<sup>th</sup> May 2022**. Volunteers were made to do various poses of yoga

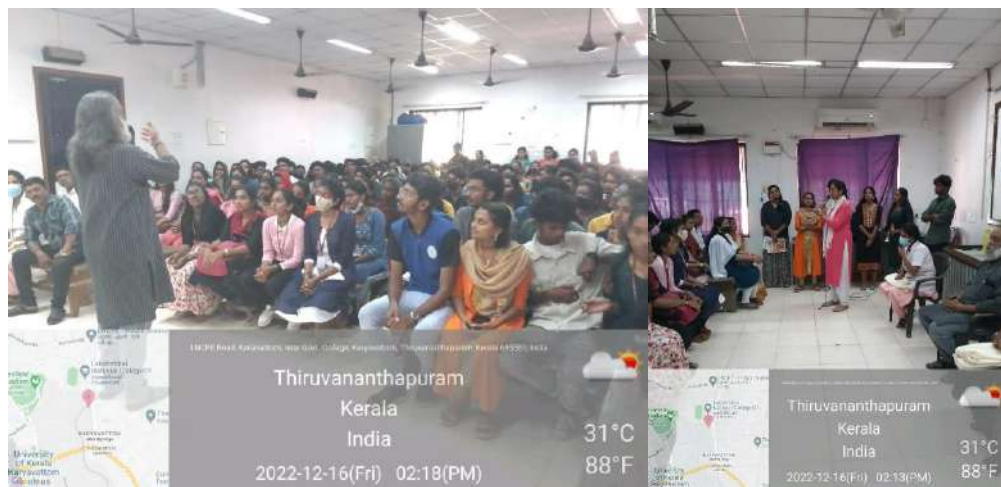

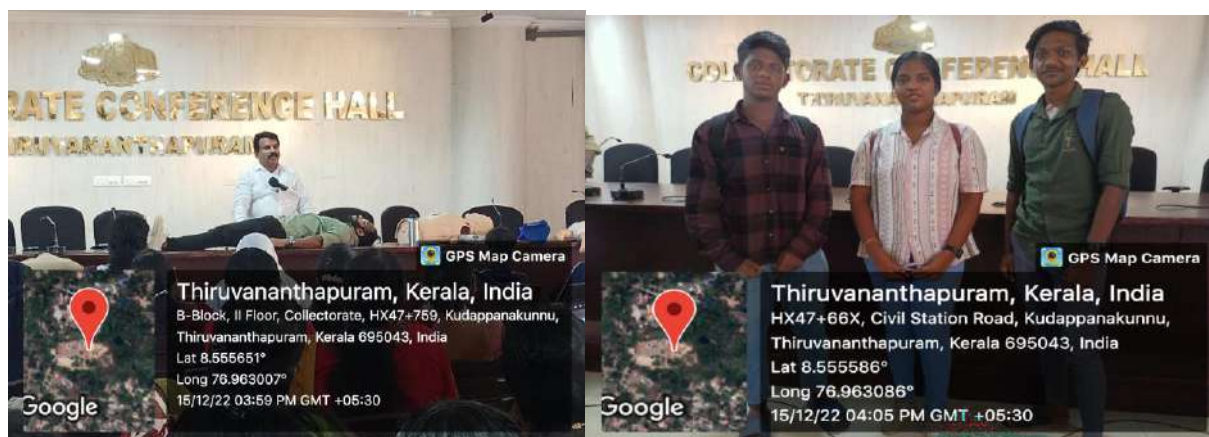
KARGIL WAR (1999)

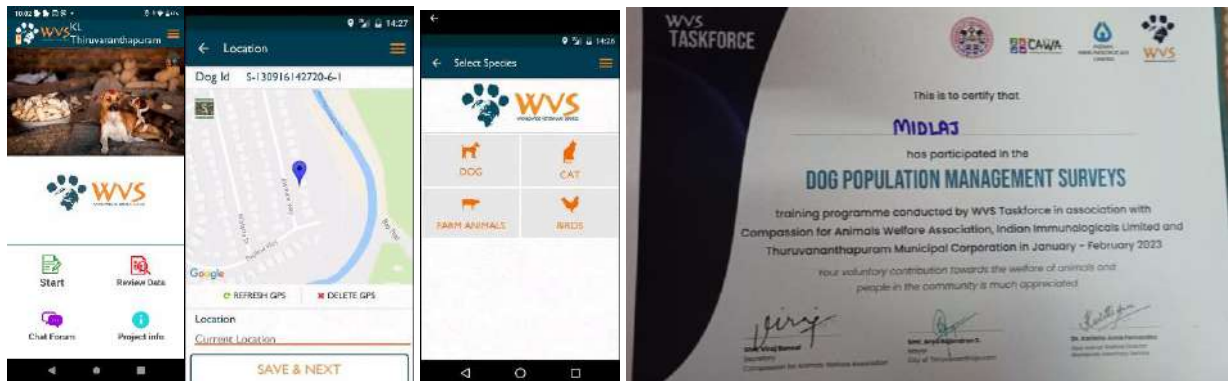


**19<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023:** A workshop on conducting dog survey was organised by the same team for NSS volunteers and Students of Geography department.

26<sup>th</sup> Jan 2023: Republic day: Cultural program, quiz was organised





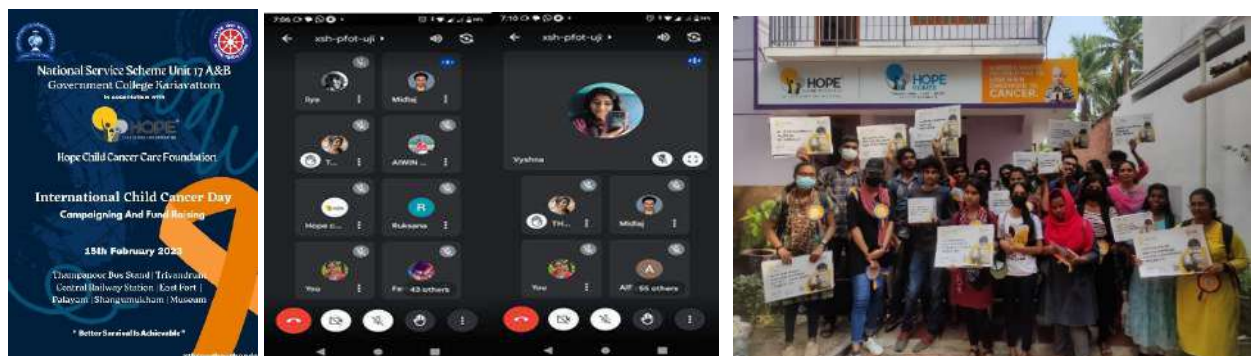

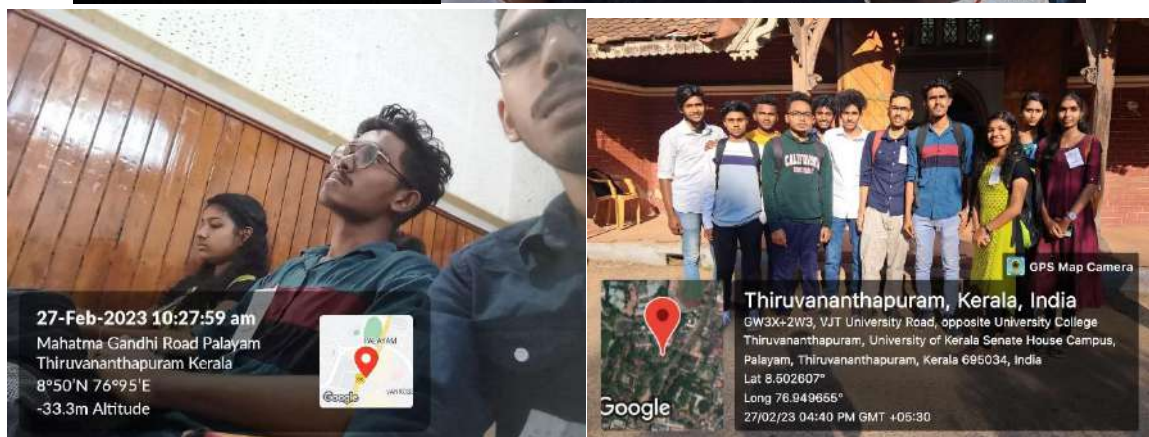
