





Every year on 11 September, National Forest Martyrs Day is marked and observed in the country. It is a day to pay tribute to those who sacrificed their lives to protect the wildlife, forests, and jungles in India.

In association with Forest Martyr's Day National Service Scheme of Government College Kariavattom organised two days National Webinar from 10<sup>th</sup> Sep 2021 to 11<sup>th</sup> Sep 2021. We conducted the program in G meet and streamed it on YouTube (<a href="https://youtu.be/IiMa0\_BUVKs">https://youtu.be/IiMa0\_BUVKs</a>). 191 participants attended the webinar on you tube and 91 participants attended via G meet. We had almost thirty participants from other states in addition to our faculty and students.


**Day 1:** Inaugural session was conducted from 9.30 to 10.00 am. The program was presided by Dr. Sabeen H. M. (IQAC Coordinator). The webinar was inaugurated by Dr. Kannan C S Warrier, Principal Senior Principal Scientist (Scientist F), Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB), Coimbatore. 




Prize winning photographs




Other Entries
