Greetings of the day!

As per the proceedings no: ASAPHQ/205/2021-CLS-IO-LIN, it is decided that all the Foundation Module batches are cancelled. Only those batches that have completed up to 100% are considered for completion and Aptis test.

In these circumstances, it is decided that -

- 1) APTIS assessment should be conducted only for those batches which are 100% complete in MIS as on 23rd April 202
- 2) All other FM batches are cancelled irrespective of the batch progression and APTIS will not be conducted for such
- 3) The service of the SDE invigilators are not to be availed and the SDC PM will be the invigilator for the APTIS assessments that are to be conducted.
- 4) Institution funds will not be sanctioned any further.

Objectives

• To create an alumni of ASAP in every college associated with ASAP. • To have an active link with the student community. • To disseminate new initiatives of ASAP to the student community. • To create a platform for the students to gather occasionally and have meaningful discussions and seminars on global trends in jobs and skill sets. • To provide the industry connect support for the institution. • To provide grooming sessions including interview preparations to students as part of placement support. • As a feeding point for developing customized training programs. • To have a constant liaison with the teaching fraternity.

Structure

• Every institution associated with ASAP should form an ASAP cell. • The priority of membership shall be provided to former and present ASAP students. However, other students can be made part of the ASAP Cell. • The membership to ASAP cell is purely voluntary and no student is compelled or forced to join the cell if they do not wish to. • One student from the senior batch shall be the Chairperson of the cell. • One student either from senior batch or junior batch shall be appointed as the Treasurer. • Priority should be given to ASAP students (former/present) for the post of Chairperson and Treasurer. • One faculty member assigned to ASAP shall be the Faculty Coordinator of the cell. At least one faculty should be associated with the club. • There will not be any upper or lower limit in the membership of the cell. There shall be a WhatsApp group for each ASAP Cell. • The Programme Manager assigned to the institution shall be the Advisor of the cell. • Skill Development Executive (SDE) assigned to the institution shall be a Joint Advisor of the cell

Benefits to the members

• To provide the members with training programmes/courses which will help them in their desired career path. • Placement grooming sessions, Mock Interviews, Aptitude tests, etc with the support of Industry. • Badges can be provided as Activity Points to the members against the active involvement in club activities. These Activity points can be redeemed against future ASAP Training programmes as early bird offers or fee subsidy. • Can make them part of ASAP events such as volunteers for Hackathons, Industry Meets, Placement drives, etc. • Alumni connect. • Exclusive Faculty Development programmes for the faculty member coordinating the activities of ASAP cell

As per the order number ASAPHQ/524/2021/STRATG-MGMT dated16/08/2021 created an ASAP cell in Government college Kariavattom on 13/09/2021.41 students were joined in ASAP Cell. Ajesh S (former BC students) selected as chairperson and Athira S (former BC students) selected as treasurer. Most of our students participated in various seminar conducted by ASAP Kerala.


