




Day 1 (23rd Dec 2021, Thursday): CAMP INAUGURATION & REGISTRATION

After the session, volunteers were divided into two groups. One group focused on making cloth banner and the other group cleaned the campus.



After dinner Christmas cake was cut and volunteers organised cultural program.








Day 4 (26th Dec 2021, Sunday): Garden Setting, Awareness Class, Roadside Cleaning
