Action Taken Report based on Feedback 2019-2020

ACTION TAKEN REPORT(2019-2020)

The feedback collected from students were analysed by IQAC and the following actions were taken. Several issues were highlighted in the feedback received from students.

From the students' feedback, the difficulties faced by them are

- Some of the students feel that the allocation of credits to course is not up to the mark.
- Some of the necessary subject areas are not sufficiently covered in the curriculum.
- Some students feel that the curriculum is not effective for career and higher education options.

As these issues collectively contribute to a less than optimal educational experience for students, impacting their overall learning outcomes and satisfaction with their academic journey the following actions were taken by IQAC.

IQAC conducted meetings with faculty members and addressed the issues raised by students. The teachers gave clarification on the credits assigned to courses. The teachers ensured that the subject areas that are mandatory in the course will be included in the next syllabus revision.

Library infrastructure which includes e-resources is an area which was mentioned by the faculty that needs improvement. Several measures were taken up by the IQAC to increase the resources in the library by the next academic year.

The Alumni of the college have a complaint regarding the fact that they are sometimes not intimated about the functions of the college. However, the alumni association of the college were instructed to inform them on any upcoming programmes well in advance. Alumni also expressed that their accessibility as alumni to college is not up to the expectation. However, the frequency of interaction and accessibility is far better compared to previous years.
