## ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2021-2022)

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- Many students feel that the size of the syllabus is vast for some courses.
- Some students feel that the curriculum has not been helpful to achieve adequate knowledge in subject area up to their expectation.

As these issues collectively contribute to a less than optimal educational experience for students, impacting their overall learning outcomes and satisfaction with their academic journey. The following actions were taken by IQAC.

IQAC conducted meetings with faculty members and addressed the issues raised by students. The contents of some of the courses will be checked and will be considered in the next syllabus revision. Moreover, the curriculum will be revised so that the students feel that adequate knowledge is imparted through the curriculum.

The Alumni of the college have a complaint regarding the fact that they are sometimes not intimated about the functions of the college. However, the alumni association of the college were instructed to inform them on any upcoming programmes well in advance. Alumni also expressed that their accessibility as alumni to college is not up to the expectation. However, the frequency of interaction and accessibility is far better compared to previous years.

Library infrastructure which includes e-resources is an area which was mentioned by the faculty that needs improvement. However, the number of e-resources has improved compared to the previous year according to teachers. More resources will be added to the library through proposals submitted for the same so that the teachers and students are beneficial. ICT enabled classrooms were also in high demand as recorded classes also needs to be prepared to be delivered to students due to COVID pandemic. IQAC decided to send a detailed proposal for the same to DCE so as to provide faculty with all privileges.
