Data was collected using sheets prepared by the feedback committee of the college under the guidance of IQAC.

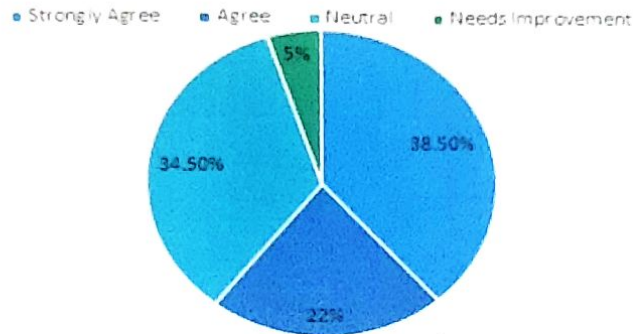
Students' feedback

Feedback was collected from both undergraduate and postgraduate students of the college using a feedback form shared with them. Fifteen criteria were used to get feedback from the students. They are

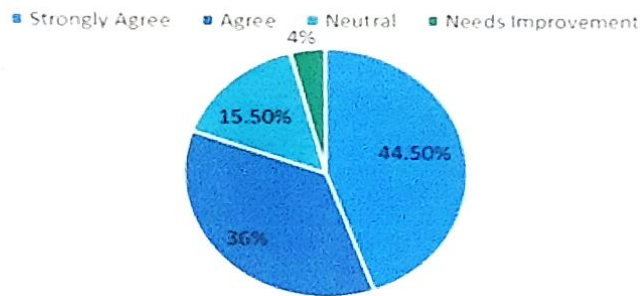
1. Syllabus generates interest in the subject area

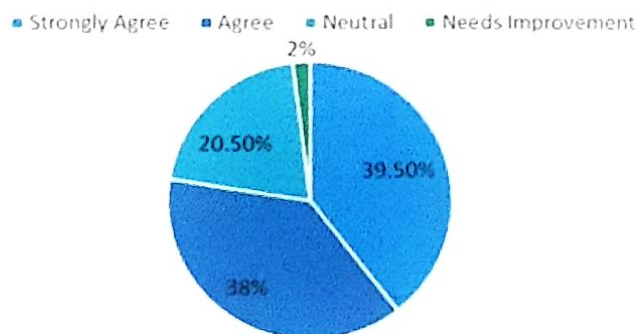
The syllabus generates interest in the subject area for the year 2022-2023



Allocation of credits to the course is fair for the year 2022-2023

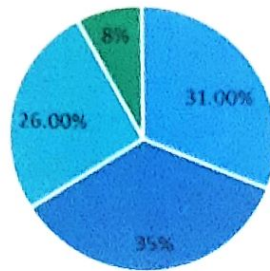


Size of the syllabus is manageable within the stipulated time for the year 2022-2023



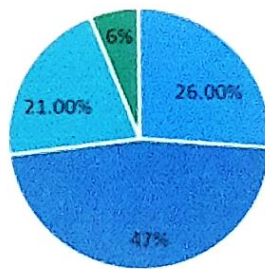
The curriculum has been helpful to achieve adequate knowledge in subject area for the year 2022-2023

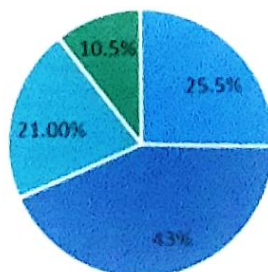
The curriculum provides effective career / higher education options for the year 2022-2023

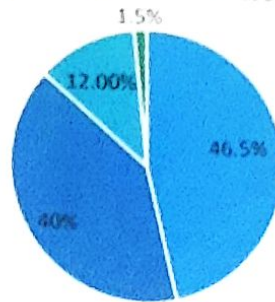
The curriculum ensures effective learning experience for the year 2022-2023

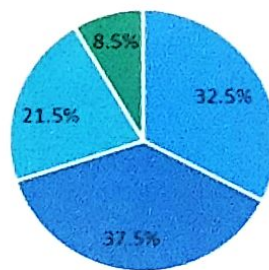
The syllabus has effective balance between theory and practicals / field work for the year 2022-2023

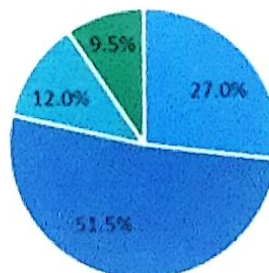
The curriculum ensures overall development of students for the year 2022-2023

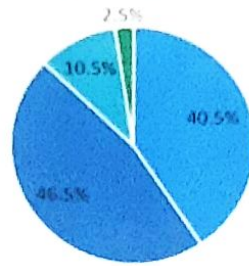
Teachers focus on knowledge updation and quality enhancement for the year 2022-2023

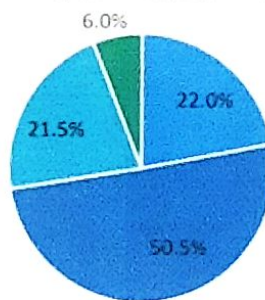
Classroom transactions enable better interaction with students and timely syllabus completion for the year 2022-2023

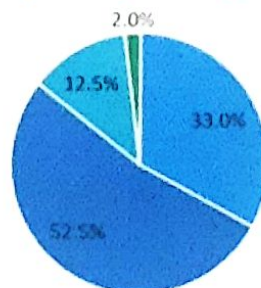
The college promotes effective blended learning approach for the year 2022-2023

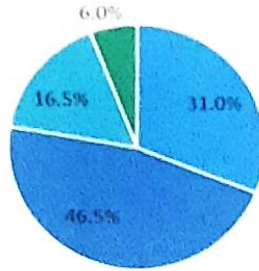
The college follows an unbiased evaluation method maintaining transparency for the year 2022-2023

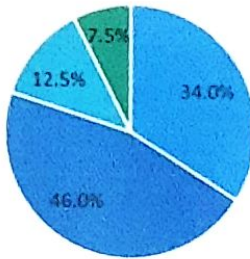
The college library offers sufficient learning resources for the year 2022-2023

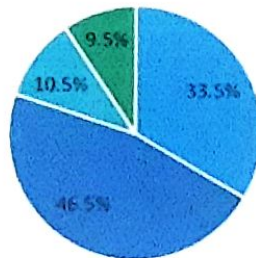
Infrastructural facilities provided by the college are adequate for the year 2022-2023

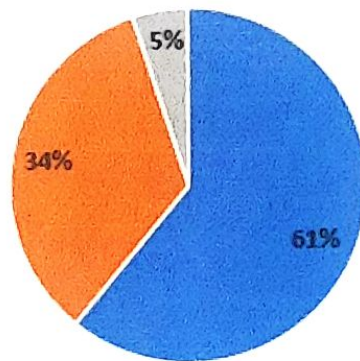
Alumni Feedback

3. Frequency of interaction with the college

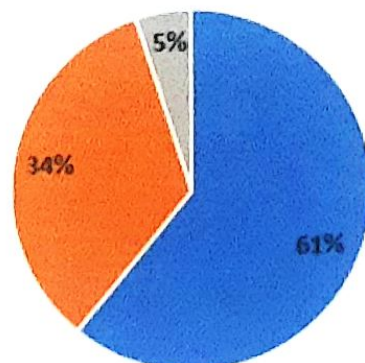
Utility of the programme studied in the college for the Year 2022-2023

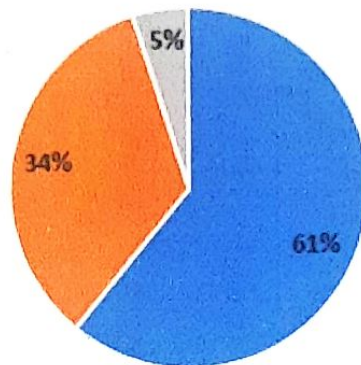
Frequency of interaction with the college for the Year 2022-2023

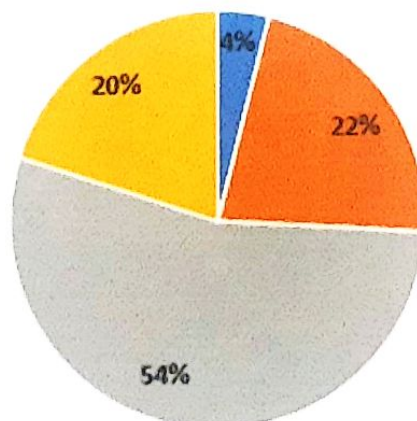
Teachers' Feedback

6. ICT Enabled teaching infrastructure

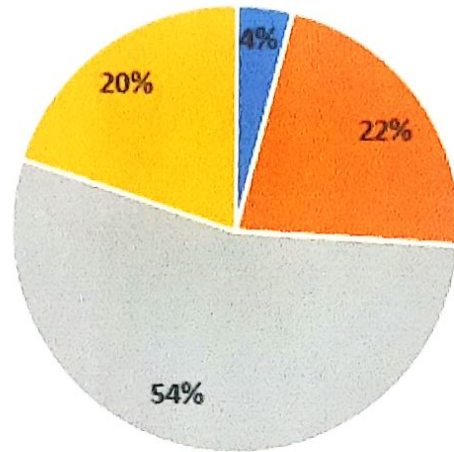
Academic Curriculum for the Year 2022-2023

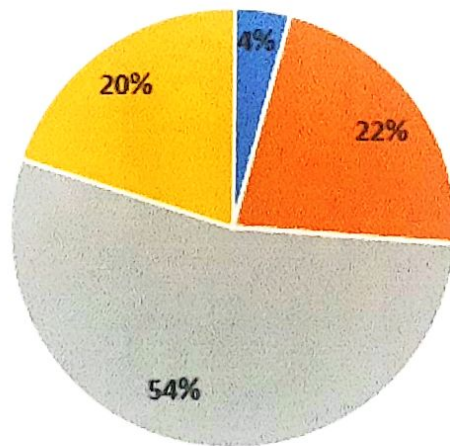
Academic Environment for the Year 2022-2023

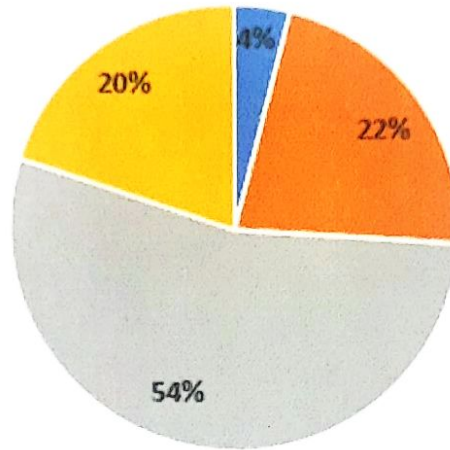
Library Infrastructure for the Year 2022-2023

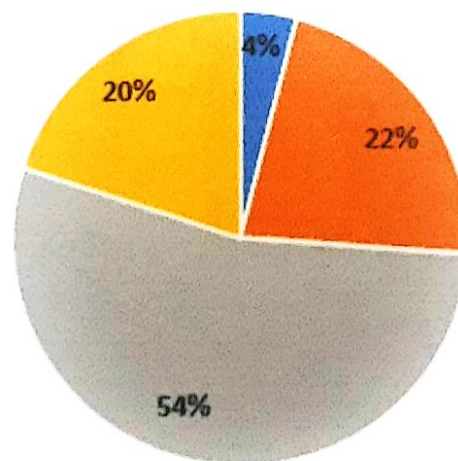
Office Administration for the Year 2022-2023

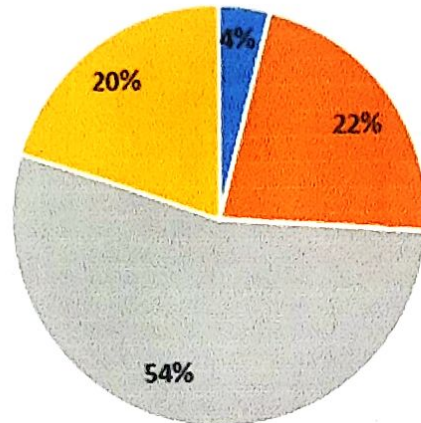
Classroom Teaching Infrastructure for the Year 2022-2023
