#### 1. CURRICULAR ASPECTS: CURRICULAR PLANNING & IMPLEMENTATION

★ Goal: Achieving Academic Excellence

#### \* Action Plan :

- Implementing bridge courses to prepare the students admitted to the non-conventional courses (Biochemistry, Biotechnology, industrial chemistry etc) offered by the college, in which the students might not have top level knowledge that they would have otherwise acquired via the school curriculum.
- Implementing a Learning Management System (LMS) which will serve as a comprehensive platform for online course delivery, student engagement, and resource management, thus enhancing accessibility, flexibility, and interactivity in the learning experience for both students and faculty members.
- Implementing curriculum to attain Course Outcome and Program Outcome.
- Preparing an academic calendar annually in alignment with the University schedule and striving to adhere to the designated timeframes as closely as feasible.
- Ensuring the effective implementation of the academic guidelines laid down by the University.
- Promoting faculty participation in workshops, training sessions, and other activities aimed at curriculum revision.
- Encouraging departments to organize seminars & workshops to update the faculty and students about the recent developments in concerned disciplines and facilitate the interaction of students & faculty members with eminent academicians & researchers.
- Organizing Student Seminar Series to improve the presentation skills and knowledge of students.
- Promoting the use of ICT enabled tools and online resources to make the teaching learning process more effective and personalized.
- Providing guidance and support to the students to enhance the depth in their knowledge in topics not covered in the regular curriculum via online courses of SWAYAM, NPTEL etc.
- Introducing more Post Graduate courses and multidisciplinary courses through which
  the college can broaden the academic horizons and provide students with diverse
  learning opportunities that align with current industry demands and societal needs.

# 2. TEACHING LEARNING & EVALUATION

#### ★ Goal 1: Transparent Evaluation Mechanism

#### \* Action Plan:

- Conducting regular centralized internal examinations and addressing grievances, if any, raised in this regard, on time.
- Carrying out regular result analysis and DLMC meetings to analyse the academic status
  of each student and conducting PTA meetings to update the parents regarding status of
  their wards in academics.
- Encouraging experiential /participative learning among students in order to make the teaching-learning process more student centric.
- Improving the evaluation process by conducting interactive sessions, group discussions, group seminars etc, apart from the conventional test and assignments.

# ★ Goal 2: Catering to Student Diversity

#### ★ Action Plan:

- Conducting regular class assignments to identify both slow and advanced learners and provide support systems to cater their needs through various programs like Student Seminar Series for advanced learners and support programs for slow learners which includes remedial coaching, peer teaching etc., utilizing the potential of advanced learners.
- Creating an inclusive environment by catering to the academic needs of students through educational experiences practiced with reference to gender, ethnicity, social class and differently abled.
- Assisting foreign students in breaking communication barriers through measures for the development of English and basic regional language skills.
- Improving the utilization of the tutorial system for the overall development of students.



# 3. RESEARCH AND EXTENSION

# ★ Goal 1: Promoting Research

#### ★ Action Plan:

- Setting up a research committee to coordinate research activities among the faculty and students.
- Establish a journal club to promote reading research articles and discussion among the research community of the college.
- Encouraging collaborations with other academic institutions and research centers.
- Establishing an incubation centre to support student and faculty startups.
- Encouraging interdisciplinary collaboration among faculty and students.
- Upgrading laboratories and establishing research centres in the college.
- Motivating faculties to apply for research guideship and research projects funded by state/national agencies.
- Organizing seminars and workshops in connection with Research Methodology,
   Intellectual Property Rights and Entrepreneurship.

Providing career advice/counselling with the help of Career Guidance/Placement cell.



- Setting systems supportive of learning and personal development.

- Promoting mentoring systems to identify the potential and shortcomings of the mentees and give appropriate guidance for their holistic development.
- Providing coaching for students in competitive entrance examinations for higher studies.
- Providing certificate courses with an aim to improve the employability of the students.
- Organizing department wise orientation programs through the active involvement of distinguished Alumni of the department.

- Practising energy conservation measures through installation of solar panels, use of energy efficient LED lighting.
- Conducting green audit, environmental audit and energy audit as part of sustainability practice in our institution.
- Promoting environmental and sustainability activities beyond the campus.
- Initiating campus beautification by landscaping and gardening with flowering and ornamental plants.
- Discouraging the use of vehicles inside the campus by constructing pedestrian friendly pathways.

- Constructing ramps, walkways with tactile tiles and handrails for ease of mobility.
- Providing Divyangjan specific toilet facility.
