#### . Introduction

As part of the observance of the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, the State NSS Cell, Thiruvananthapuram, organized a series of awareness programmes on 26th June message of a drug-free lifestyle among youth and students. The initiatives were conducted under the leadership of the Department of Higher Education, Government of Kerala.

#### 1. Inaugural Session

The **official inauguration** of the Anti-Drug Day celebration was held at **Women's College**, **Vazhuthacaud** at **9:30 AM**. The event was formally inaugurated by **Dr. R. Bindu**, Hon'ble Minister for Higher Education, Government of Kerala. In her address, the Minister emphasized the importance of drug awareness and the **significant role of students and educational institutions** in combating substance abuse.



#### 2. Debate Competition

Following the inauguration, a **debate competition** was organized by the **College Union of Women's College, Vazhuthacaud**. The topic of the debate was:

#### "Drugs: Legal or Illegal - Are We Aware of the Dangers?"

NSS volunteers from multiple institutions actively participated in the session. Participants critically examined the implications of both legal and illegal drug use, discussed the dangers involved, and emphasized the importance of **awareness and education** in preventing substance abuse.
