Umashankar gave a brief introduction about the good response received from the society for the Casthrojan 2018' programme. He conveyed the appreciation given by the Director of Collegiate Education Dr. A.S. Jaya IAS, after her visit to the stalls of our expo.

The committee evaluated the

activities of the last year in connection with the enhancement of quality matters.

- a) Faculty development programmes were arranged for the teaching and non-teaching staffs.
- b) Feedback responses were taken from the students and parents.
- c) General and class wise PTA meetings helps for the maintenance of discipline of the college.
- d) Seminars organised by the departments with the help of eminent personalities gave a great exposure of the subjects to the students.

- 7) Laboratories to be modernized with equipments.
- 8) Carrier guidance cell to be given more attention.
- 9) Strengthening/Uplifting of classrooms to be done.
- 10) To improve the classroom availability, action

to be taken for the construction of the remaining blocks connecting A & F blocks, as per the plan.

The committee discussed the upcoming admissions for the UG and PG students. Admission procedures are stipulated by the Government and the University of Kerala to be followed. The committee suggested to keep a database of all students in the Placement cell. Hence the forms related to the admissions (Admit Card/ Affidavit / I.T Card) to be received at the concerned department to associate with PTA.

The committee decided to ask the concerned to speed up the procedural works for the KIIFB constructions and the pending of the internal roadway system and the allied blocks. Also the committee noted the shortage of a good auditorium to accommodate the students of the college. Hence it was decided to put up a proposal for the auditorium and also form a board for future want proposal to have a transformer for the college to be submitted to the concerned at the earliest. The other relief fund collected by the NSS to be handed over to the affected.

The success of an educational institution depends upon the output of the students. Hence the teaching-learning process has to be effectively implemented.  - ① Identifying the talents in various cultural programmes and advance training to be given to them well ahead of the University level competitions
 - ② A team of students to be selected to represent the college in Debate & Quiz competitions
 - ③ Students are to be motivated to put up media activities - print/audio/video
 - 4) Social justice group to arrange various awareness programmes concerning anti-ragging, anti-narcotics, sexual harassment & prevention, human rights etc.
 - 5) Service to the students and staff has also to be given much care.
- Student counselling cells has to identify the students in need of their service.
- Placement cell has to organise awareness programmes on higher studies also to motivate the under graduate students.
- Equal opportunity cell services should be given to the minority group to address their needs.

Girl students and the women employees has to be cared through the women Study Centre and Women welfare Committee. A meeting of the same to be convened every month.

An awareness programme on Health Education to be organised to keep the students physically and mentally fit.

All the coordinators are directed to chart their programmes and handover to the IGAC coordinated by 15th of August 2019.

The meeting of the executive members of IQAC and PTA of the college were held at the Seminar Hall on 29-9-2018. Principal, Dr. Unnikrishnan Nair welcomed the participants and informed the relief work undertaken by the students and staff during the recent flood affected period. During

the time a camp was started at the college to collect the relief materials to be supplied at the SMV relief camp centre Tiruvannamalai for air lifting to the flood affected areas. Moreover the College PTA supplied a lorry full of relief materials directly to Chenganoor flood affected area. Other than materials, fund were collected and handed over to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund also. The meeting appreciated the timely efforts taken by the college authority & students during the flood time.

IQAC coordinator then described the Plan of Action to be implemented for the quality improvement of the teaching learning processes. A detailed discussion was carried out in various matters and the following decisions were taken.

- i) To have a good evaluation of tutorial system, attendance has to be timely monitored and hence directed PTA to provide financial help for the printing of attendance sheets.
- ii) To demarcate the students of 1st year, Identity Cards are to be given at the earliest with a different tag colour than the present 2nd & 3rd year students.
- iii) As the college is spread over a wide area and the electric lighting facilities are not properly maintained by the Government, the meeting decided to provide help for the PTA to rectify the damages and lights the lamps in the campus.
- iv) As the public water supply is frequently interrupting, the meeting decided to rectify the electric pump installed in the well for sufficient water supply in campus.
- v) As the departments are not getting the funds in time from the Government, it is decided to provide advance to such departments for the smooth functioning.
- vi) The meeting appreciated the efforts taken by the PTA in getting the new course for the college. The meeting directed the PTA to start a programme in connection with the inauguration of the new course, availing the presence of our

MIA & Honble minister and/or the Honble Mayor of Thiruvananthapuram Corporation. It was also decided to reallocate certain classrooms/staffrooms to accommodate the classrooms for the newly allotted M.Sc. Mathematics course.

The meeting gave full support to the various jubilee programmes scheduled for the year. The meeting also decided to give support to the smooth conduct of the upcoming College Union Elections.

The meeting came to an end at 4:25 pm.
