Our radio programs are broadcasted during the lunch break each day, excluding university examination days, from 12.30 to 1.30 pm. The designation '7.1' signifies the seven main departments along with the postgraduate mathematics department. The abbreviation 'HP' stands for 'horsepower,' symbolizing a distinct tribute to the research department of physics. Our radio broadcasts are streamed live through speakers positioned in classrooms and are also relayed through open loudspeakers.

Leading the efforts of the Media Club is Mr. Sudheer B, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Chemistry, who is effectively coordinating the program. Enthusiastic students from diverse departments actively participate as members.
